- 1) Pledge of Allegiance
- 2) Deater opened the meeting for public comment on the proposed ORV ordinance.
- 3) Public Comment:
  - a) Glenn Spaulding commented that he was in favor of passing an ordinance allowing ORV traffic on township roads. He stated he was recently in Buckley and witnessed a considerable amount of ORV traffic in town and they were not tearing up the roads. Glenn said he did see spots where ORVs had gone off-road up the side of banks. Glenn said he was in the woods a lot and never saw ORVs but did see them on the roads.
  - b) Gerald Clark stated he was in favor of allowing ORVs on township roads and doesn't think drivers will go off road on private property.
- 4) Communication/Correspondence: Conley stated the township received the following correspondence from the public following posting of the notice in the paper and on the website:
  - a) MDOT email related to connector routes and
  - b) Otto township email requesting missing pages of the Ordinance copy they received.
- 5) Next steps: Conley stated the next steps will be to finalize the ordinance, put the topic on the October meeting agenda for consideration/potential adoption, publish the ordinance if adopted, and then the ordinance would become effective after 30 days of when it is published.
