- 1) Call to Order by Hunt at 6:32
- 2) Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 3) Roll Call: Members present Hunt, Gustman, Budde & Conley at 6:30 PM. Deater at 6:50 PM.
- 4) Public Comment: None
- 5) Agenda was approved as presented. Motion by Hunt, Supported by Gustman. I/F 4-0
- 6) New Business:
 - a) Budget / Truth in Taxation - Conley stated the budget was developed based on the following millage rates as subject to reduction as statutorily required by the Headlee reduction fraction: Operating 1.2081, Fire .9649 and Road Repairs/Improvements of 1.5000.
 - b) Hunt presented the budget by activity (cost) center:
 - i) Holcomb commented the Planning commission is going to discuss prep of master plan and if they do it themselves, he believes cost will be under \$7000.
 - ii) Holcomb asked about the cost of paving Roosevelt. Hunt responded the prior year quote was \$478,000.00. Holcomb stated with road millage raising an estimated \$112,000.00 over 2 years it is difficult to imagine Roosevelt getting repaved. Hunt and Gustman both commented that it may be achievable with a combination of the road millage funding, ARPA Fund and our Savings.
 - iii) Motion to approve the budget as presented was made by Conley, Supported by Gustman. I/F 5-0
